### 2. HISTORY:

The Faculty in its original form was established in 1919, at the same time as the University itself. Initially known as the Law Faculty, it subsequently transformed into the Faculty of Law and Social and Economic Studies, and from 1921, the Faculty of Law and Economy. In the late 1960s its name changed again into the Faculty of Law and Administration and as such it has functioned to date.

The Faculty of Law and Administration of the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań is one of the largest law schools in Poland and has been consistently rated as one of the best in the country. Currently, it employs over a hundred teachers who work in nineteen Chairs specialising in different fields of legal studies. The Faculty has also a foreign languages unit which offers classes in legal English, French and German.

The Faculty meets the requirements of contemporary trends in higher education by conducting high level research studies. The academic staff recognise the demands of social processes and seek to create value for the society, science, culture and economy.
